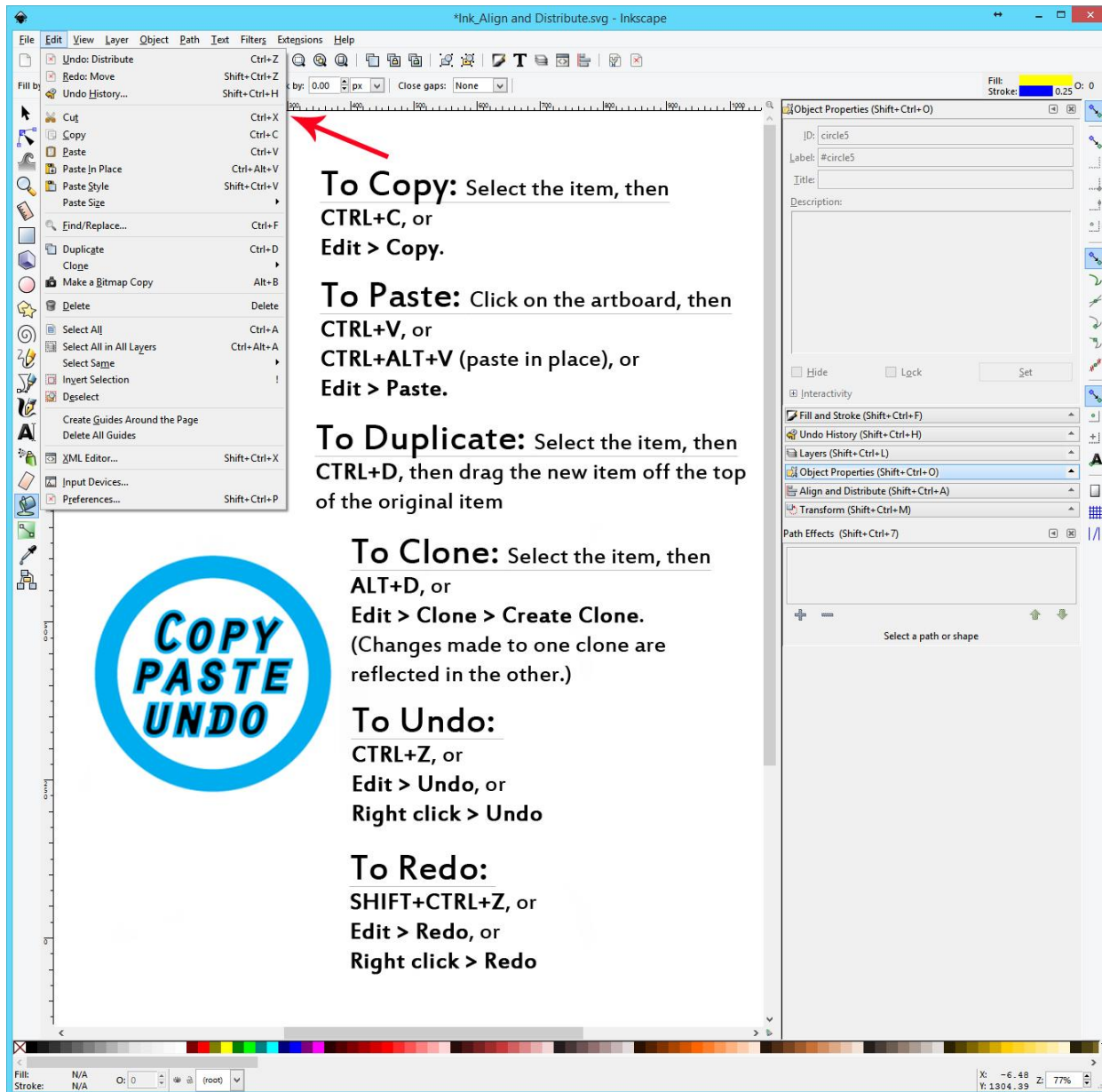


Inkscape: Copy/Paste/Clone/Undo/Redo

Inkscape gives several options for copying, pasting and undoing a step you just took. **CTRL+Z** is a very powerful and useful keystroke...you can continue to step backwards in your design by repeating the **CTRL+Z** command.

To Copy: Select the item, then **CTRL+C**, or **Edit > Copy**.

To Paste: Click on the artboard, then **CTRL+V**, or **CTRL+ALT+V** (paste in place), or **Edit > Paste**.

To Duplicate: Select the item, then **CTRL+D**, then drag the new item off the top of the original item

To Clone: Select the item, then **ALT+D**, or **Edit > Clone > Create Clone**. (Changes made to one clone are reflected in the other.)

To Undo: **CTRL+Z**, or **Edit > Undo**, or **Right click > Undo**

To Redo: **SHIFT+CTRL+Z**, or **Edit > Redo**, or **Right click > Redo**
