


Grouping and Ungrouping

When you group items together, you can move them around as one unit, perform operations on them, get an overall measurement for the group, and scale everything in the group equally.

1. Select the items to be grouped, then either:
CTRL+G (to group)
or
Right Click > Group
or
Object > Group

2. To Ungroup, click the group then:
Object > Ungroup
or
SHIFT+CTRL+G
