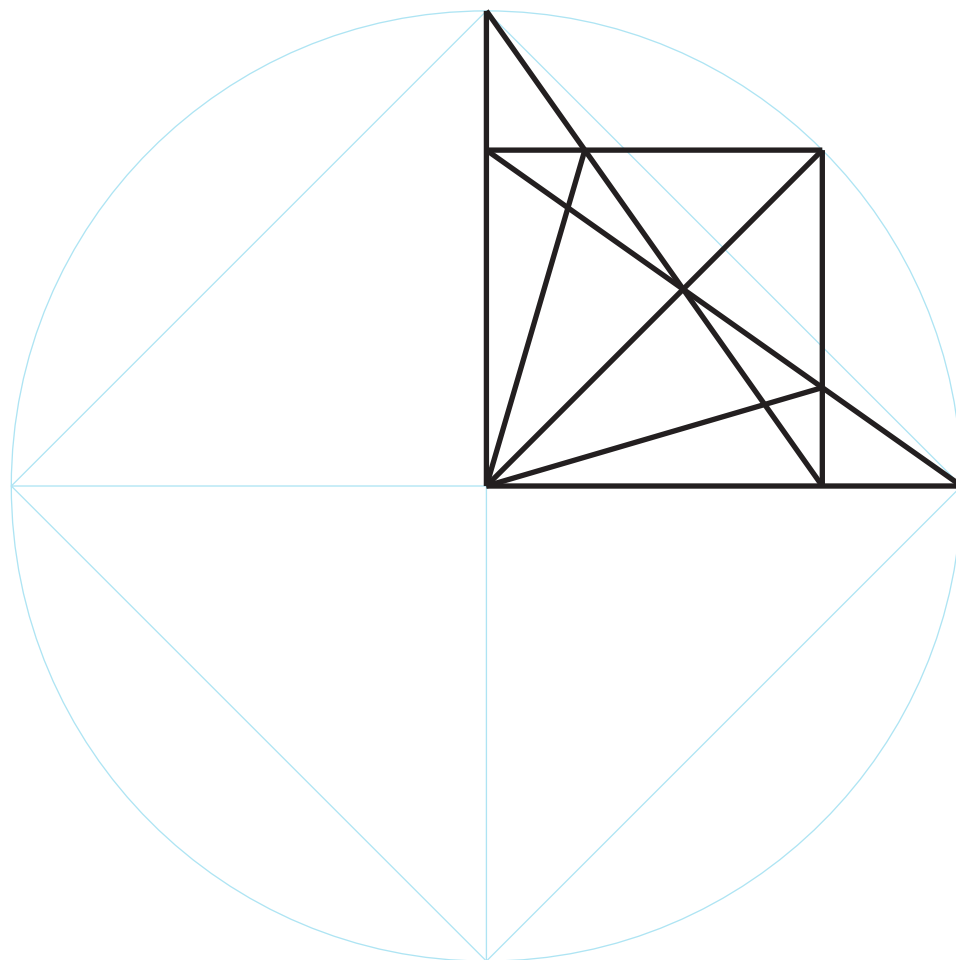


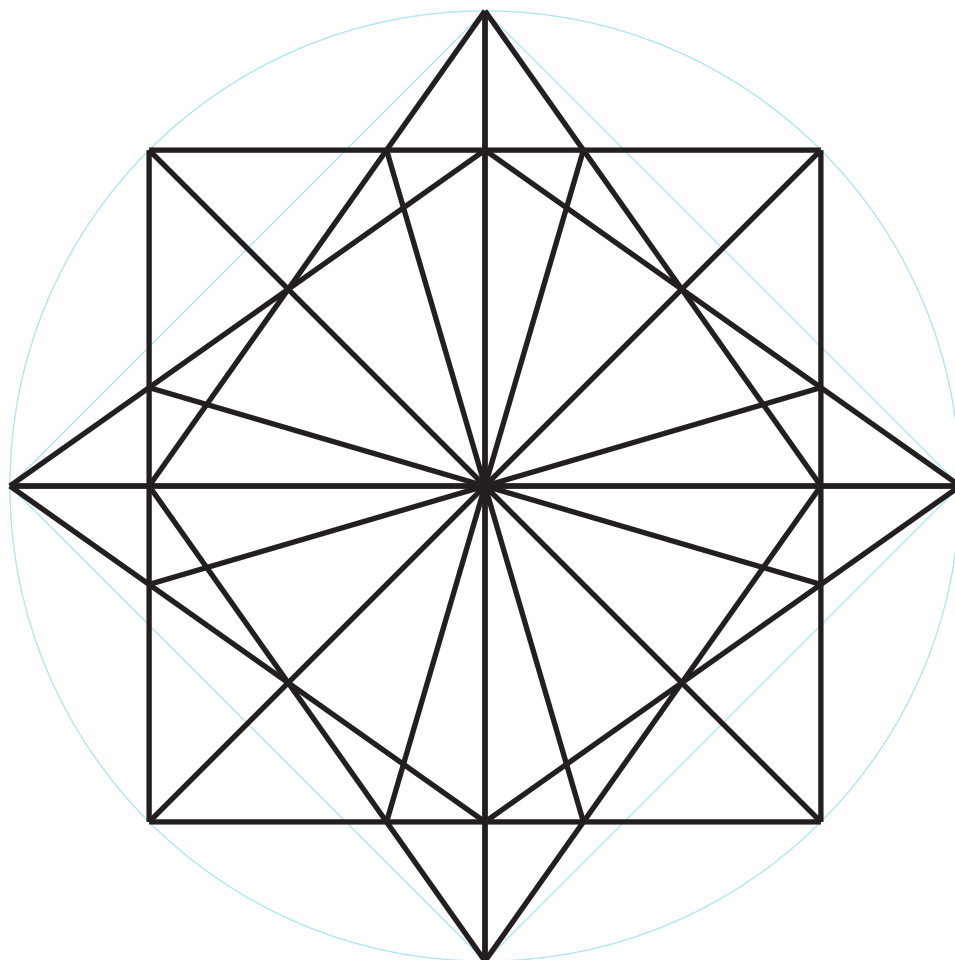
### 1: Line Drawing

Create the basics of a repeating pattern using one quadrant of a circle, square, or diamond and straight lines. Don't worry about joining the lines, just focus on snapping the ends of the lines to each other precisely so they can be joined cleanly later on.



### 2: Group, Mirror, and Repeat

Take the segment you've created and group it so that it can be copied, rotated, mirrored, and snapped to the template in order to complete the pattern.



### 3: Repeat into a Broader Pattern

Copy the object and place it on a repeating grid. Consider adjusting every other row by rotation or scale to create interest and avoid overlaps.
