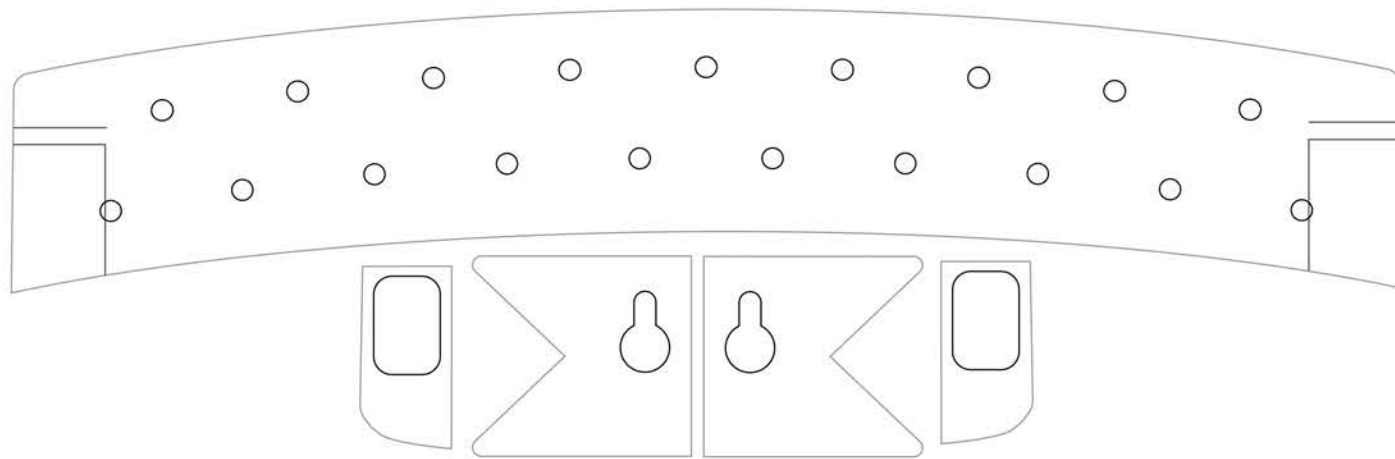
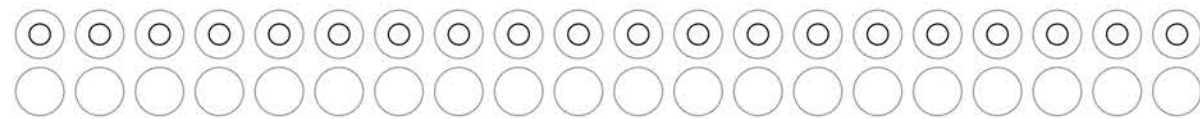


Cutting

Cut from 1/8" wood or medium Proofgrade plywood.
Score purple lines; cut black lines first then green lines.



Cut from Proofgrade veneer. Cut black lines first then green lines.



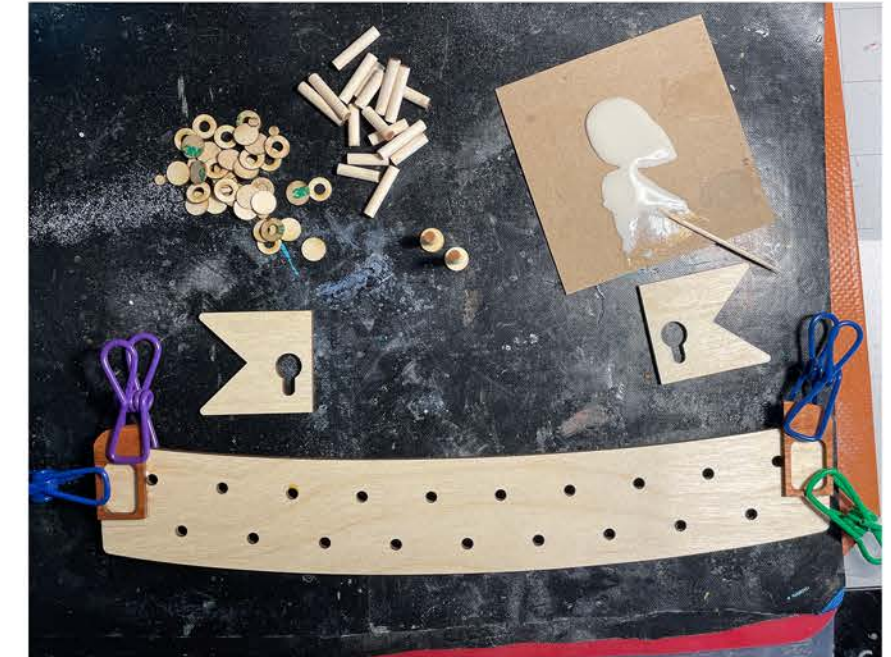
Use these lines to cut the 3/16" wooden dowels into ten 1 inch segments and nine 3/4 inch segments. Lay the dowels horizontally across the bed. Medium draftboard settings should cut the dowels.



Assembly

1. Stain or paint the two middle pieces of wood, for contrast. Glue them as shown, with the flat end even with the lower scored line.

2. Glue the flag end pieces on top of the middle pieces, with the ends oriented as shown, and with the top edge even with the second score line.



3. Remove masking from all the veneer pieces. For each peg, remove the release paper from a piece with hole and a piece without hole, and stick the two sticky sides together, centered. Then stick a dowel piece into the hole.



4. After all dowels have been prepared, add a bit of glue where the dowel meets the veneer, to reinforce it. After all the glue is dry, glue the dowels into the holes in the arched board. Paint or seal as desired.
