


Grouping and Ungrouping

When you group items together, you can move them around as one unit, perform operations on them, get an overall measurement for the group, and scale everything in the group equally.

1. **Select** the objects to be grouped (see Selection Tool Basics tutorial).
2. **Group** the objects by doing one of the following:
 - a. **<CTRL><G>** or
 - b. **Right Click → Group**
3. To **Ungroup**, click the group then:
 - a. **<CTRL><U>** or
 - b. **Right Click → Ungroup**
